### **Re: Sebright CC Update on Re-opening in September 2020**

This is to update you on the full re-opening of Sebright Daycare

The governmental guidelines now advise us that we are in a safe position to offer places in daycare to all children by increasing the number of children that we have in each room. In light of these new guidelines and recommendations we are in the process of preparing to re-open and expand the number of children in our setting from 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2020.

We will continue to provide care in each room within the age range of the children but we now have the capacity to increase our numbers in each room thus allowing for transition of children from one room to another and in addition the capacity to offer places to new children on our waiting list.

We will continue to endeavor to work within the confines of a bubble model as recommended by the government but we now have capacity to expand the number of children in each room and also the number of practitioners working in each room. We will continue to maintain these bubbles with a view to break and lunch time ensuring that each group moves around the building within their group bubble. Activities both indoor and outdoor play will be maintained within their group bubble.

My letter of 2<sup>nd</sup> June outlined the practice that we have in place to ensure the health and safety of your children are still in place. Strict hygiene and safe practice has and will continue to remain a priority. An amended risk assessment has been completed and is available, if you would like a copy of the center risk assessment please do contact me directly, my contact details are at the bottom of this letter.

In the new academic year, we will be introducing one late opening a month, this will be the last Wednesday of every month this is in line with other Hackney early years settings. On the late opening dates the start time will be 10am.

In September, we will once again be requesting proof of income to ensure that you are on the correct fee band.

Attached is the center closure and late opening dates for the academic year 2020/21.



If you are travelling over the summer period to a country that still requires a 14 day quarantine upon re-entry into the country, we are urging you to follow these recommendations prior to returning your child/ren to the setting.
